Rogich Students will begin taking the MAP Growth Assessment (Measured Academic Progress) on November 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. This will be the second administration of the MAP Growth Assessment this year, which will show us individual student growth since the first administration in August. Students will be testing in ELA, Math and Science classes through December 15<sup>th</sup>.

As the school year began, students were placed in academic courses based primarily on the MAP Assessment results from the Spring Assessment of 2022. As we prepare for the second semester, the upcoming data from the MAP Assessment will also drive our student placement for second semester. We encourage all students to do their very best to show the amount of growth they have demonstrated so far this year. We will be adjusting student schedules based on academic growth and individual data from this upcoming MAP administration to better meet the needs of all students.

MAP Growth is a computer-adaptive test. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. This type of assessment challenges top performers without overwhelming students whose skills are below grade level. We are provided data to identify areas in need of focus giving us an accurate measure of student proficiency. It also measures growth over time.

Teachers and Administrators have been visiting with students, reviewing data and setting goals to encourage positive effort on the assessment. We ask that you encourage students at home and understand the importance of each administration of the MAP Growth Assessment.
